

NOTICE TO MARINERS
HALFWAY REACH

L13-24**WHITE MOUNTAIN BOLLARD & FENDER WORKS**

Mariners are advised that, on or about 12th March 2024, contractors instructed by the operators of White Mountain Roadstone terminal will commence works to replace mooring bollards and renew wooden fendering on the quay wall. The general location of the works is indicated by the red box on the chartlet below:



These works will be conducted between 0700 and 1700, Monday to Friday; and will involve lifting operations, construction materials delivered by barge and personnel working on the waterline; tugs and safety boats may be in attendance. These works are expected to be complete within 7 weeks from commencement.

Requirements to proceed with caution or at slow speed will be made in accordance with the procedures set out in the Port of London Authority's Port Information Guide, under 'London VTS', 'Section 4' with the International Code Flags 'Romeo Yankee', which are illustrated below, displayed.

The display of these signals will be in addition to any lights or shapes required under local regulations and the International Regulations for Preventing Collisions at Sea.

Further details will be broadcast as appropriate by London VTS on VHF channel 14.
