
## **BELUGA WHALE**

This notice supersedes L20 of 2018, which is hereby cancelled.

Due to the ongoing presence of a beluga whale, which is an IUCN red listed species, any vessels which are not required to operate in this area are advised to keep well clear.

Vessels which need to operate in this area are required to keep a close lookout at all times. If the whale is sighted it should not be approached, speed should be reduced, and where possible a minimum distance of 100m from the whale should be maintained.
