

No 1 and 2 arches of Blackfriars Bridges will be closed for most of this period. Their re-opening will be the subject of a further Notice to Mariners.

Arches closed to navigation will be marked in accordance with the Port of London Authority Thames Byelaws 2012 namely:

- By day, three red discs 0.6 metres in diameter at the points of an equilateral triangle with the apex downwards and the base horizontal
- By night, three red lights in similar positions to the discs displayed by day.

The vessels involved will maintain a continuous listening watch on VHF channel 14. At times RY flags may be exhibited in conjunction with “proceed with caution / slow down requests” in VTS broadcasts.

Vessels are requested to be mindful of the nature of the works, be aware of vessels proceeding to and from the works, their wash when passing the works, and to pass at a safe distance particularly from any yellow pellet buoys which may be marking anchors, sinkers or other under water obstructions.

Further details will be broadcast by London VTS on VHF Channel 14.
