Vessels navigating in the area are advised that between 200 and 500 rowing vessels will be navigating before and after the closure times. All vessels are to proceed with caution and pay special attention to their wash.

Harbour Service launches exhibiting flashing blue lights will mark the limits of the closures and <u>no vessels</u> other than official safety vessels shall be underway on the courses whilst the races are in progress.

All vessels underway not participating in the races must be clear of the closed areas before the closure starts.
