STEVE FALDO & DAVE POPE BARGE RACES <i>Involves approximately six to eight Thames Rowing Barges racing under oars.</i>			
Sunday 16 th September	12:30 – 16:30	Westminster Bridge to Tower Bridge	Local Traffic Control (throughout)
THAMES APPRENTICE BARGE DRIVING RACE <i>Involves approximately four to six Thames Rowing Barges racing under oars.</i>			
Saturday 27 th October	11:30 – 14:00	Greenwich Pier to Westminster Bridge	Local Traffic Control (throughout)

Vessels involved in these events will navigate on the starboard hand side of the fairway and will be accompanied by a number of safety and support vessels.

Master's of vessels navigating throughout these events should be aware of the limited maneuverability of the some of the vessels participating in them and **should navigate at a safe speed paying particular attention to their wash.**

Local Traffic Control

When necessary, Local Traffic Control will be conducted from an attending Harbour Service Launch, Call Sign prefix **“THAMES PATROL”**.

Further information regarding each event will be broadcast by **London VTS** on **VHF Channel 14**.
